Clubhouse: As members did not take advantage of the Clubhouse and its amenities, it was frequently locked up.

Visit of the Rev. P. L. Peach. In conjunction with our brother O.B.A.'s in the Federation, the Association invited the Rev. P. L. Peach, who was the Principal of the School from 1922 to 1924, and who also started the Anglo-Chinese Continuation School, Singapore, the first of its kind in Malaysia for overaged students, to visit Malaysia. He arrived in early December and would be here till March. The Rev. Peach would be our guest of honour at the Founder's Day Reunion Dinner on Saturday, 29th February these games continued through Founder's Day to early March. Old Boys were victorious in Table-tennis (4-3), Basketball (118-50), Soccer (4-1), Hockey (4-1), Badminton (7-2) and Cricket (132-72), but lost in Volley-ball (1-3). The Old Girls also won the netball match (13-4).

Athletics: At the School Athletic Championships last May, M. Jegathesan beat the rest of the field comfortably in the 100 metres sprint for Old Boys. Second was Choo Teck Long and third place went to Maurice Nicholas. The 4 x 100 metres Relay was won by Michael Tan's team. A highlight of the Meet was the Inter-O.B.A. Relay for the Tan Chin Tuan Cup. Our quartet won, in keenly contested race, to retain the Cup.

Swimming: Last July, at the School Swimming Championships, the Past vs. Present Water-polo Match was won by the Present Boys with a score of 7-2. In the other Old Boys' Events, Chee Ping Hean not only won the 100 metres Free Style but his team also won the 4 x 50 metres Free Style Relay with Tan Gek Chee's team a close second.

Membership: As a result of 35 Life Members and 4 Annuals joining the Association, and the passing away of 4 members, membership now stands at 1,572. Of the new members, 3 are Old Girls.

Finance: The financial position continues to be satisfactory.

In Memoriam: The Association lost a distinguished member with the passing away of Mr. G. H. Kiat, O.B.E., J.P., our first President (1924), last December. His very strong support for and loyalty to the Association is deeply treasured by members.

In the death of Mr. Tan Soo Liat, another Old Boy and popular Sports Secretary of the School for the last 8 years, the Association has lost a keen sportsman and sports official.

Dr. Essel Tan Sin Lian, who passed away last February, would be missed at the School Annual Athletics Championships, as he was for many years the Field Doctor.

We also regret to record the passing away of another member, Mr. Khoo Hock Tian.
